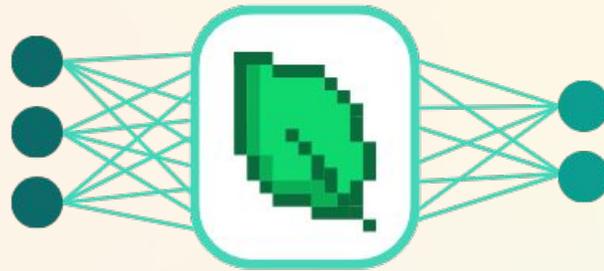

QUICK FAQs

Who is eligible to participate?

Anyone based in the US between the ages of 13-18 is eligible to participate. You don't need to be a current program participant or alumni to win!

How many winners are there?

Judges will select three middle school (ages 13-14) projects and three high school (ages 15-18) projects.

What are the prizes?

Each winning project will receive GWC swag, a project spotlight on GWC social media, and a gift card based on age category: \$250 for middle school and \$500 for high school.

Who are the judges?

Submissions will be judged by both GWC staff and our Corporate Partners, who are professionals working in tech fields. You can find supporting Partner companies on the GWC Challenge webpage.

Are there resources available to help me get started?
